### ***Format of presentations***

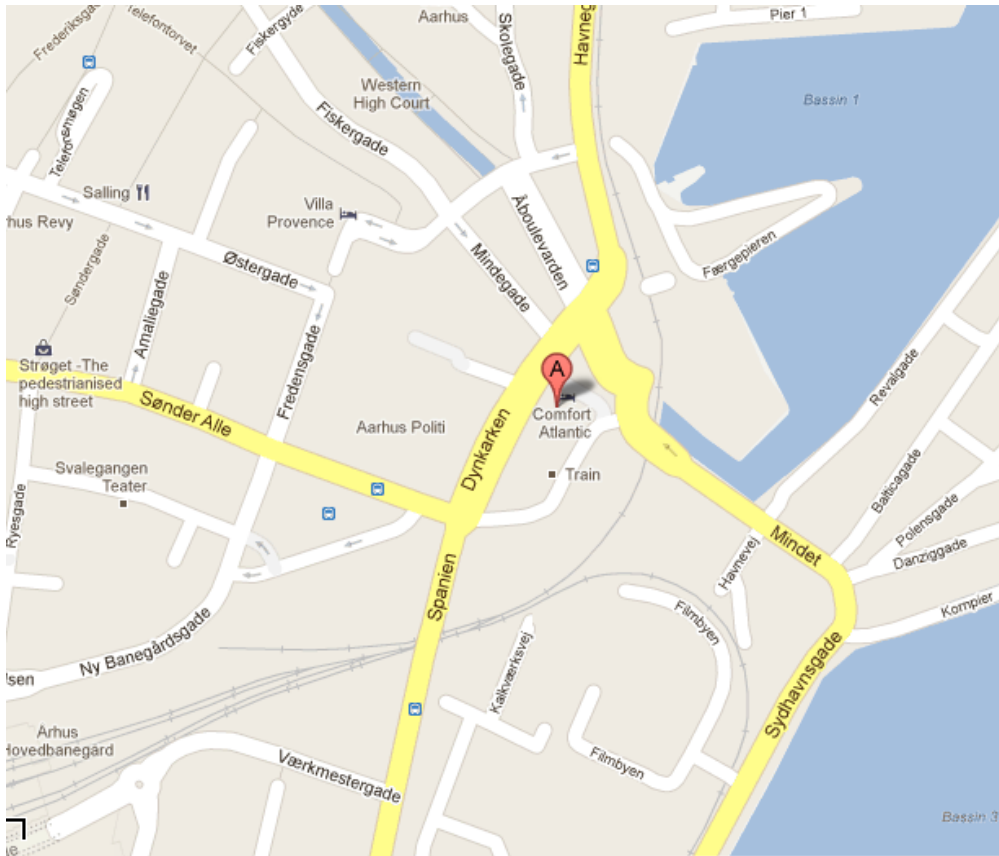

## ***Practical information***

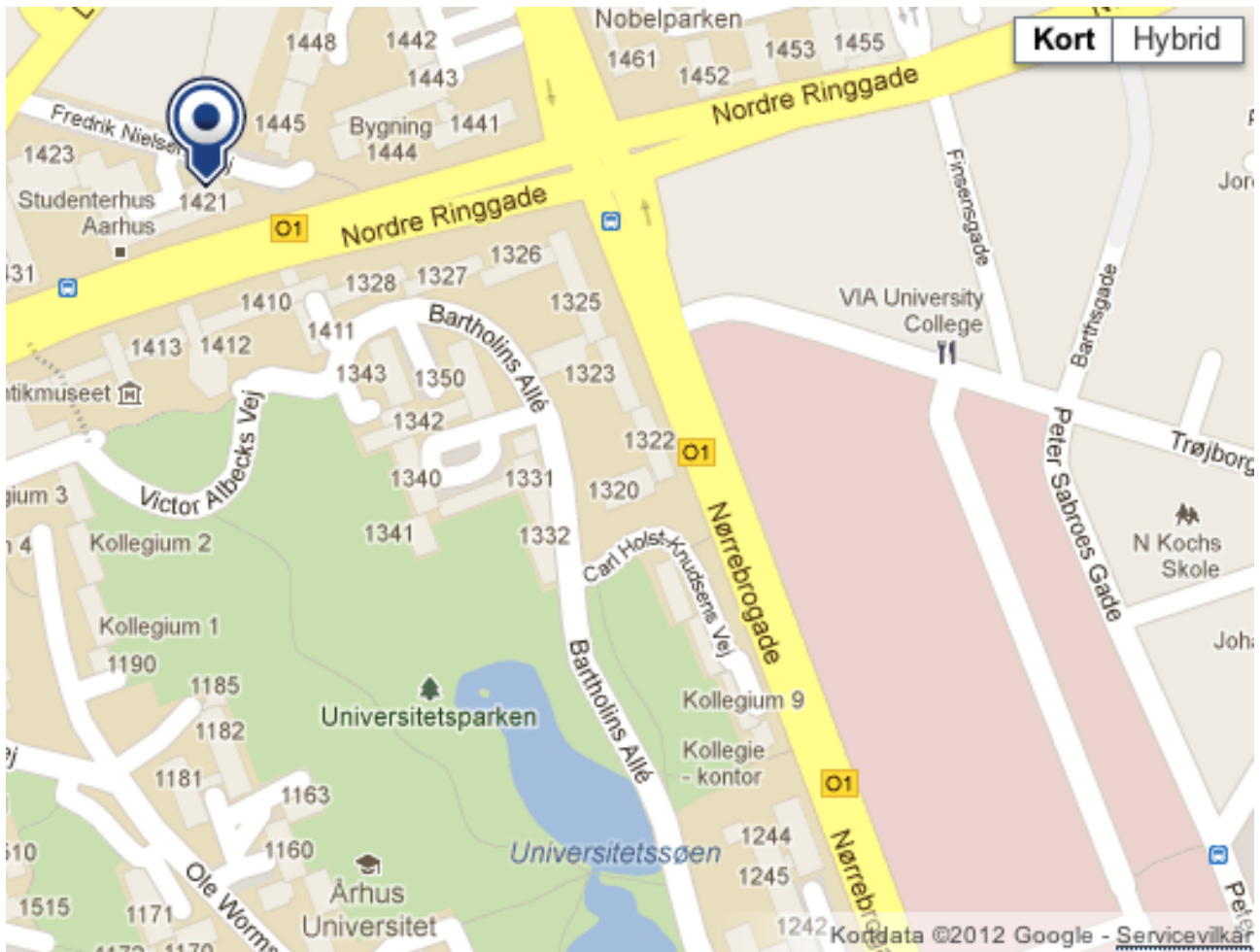
Hotel: Guests will be staying at the Atlantic Hotel, Europaplads 10, 8000 Aarhus C, which is near the City Centre and the harbour.

Dinner will be at the Department of Political Science.

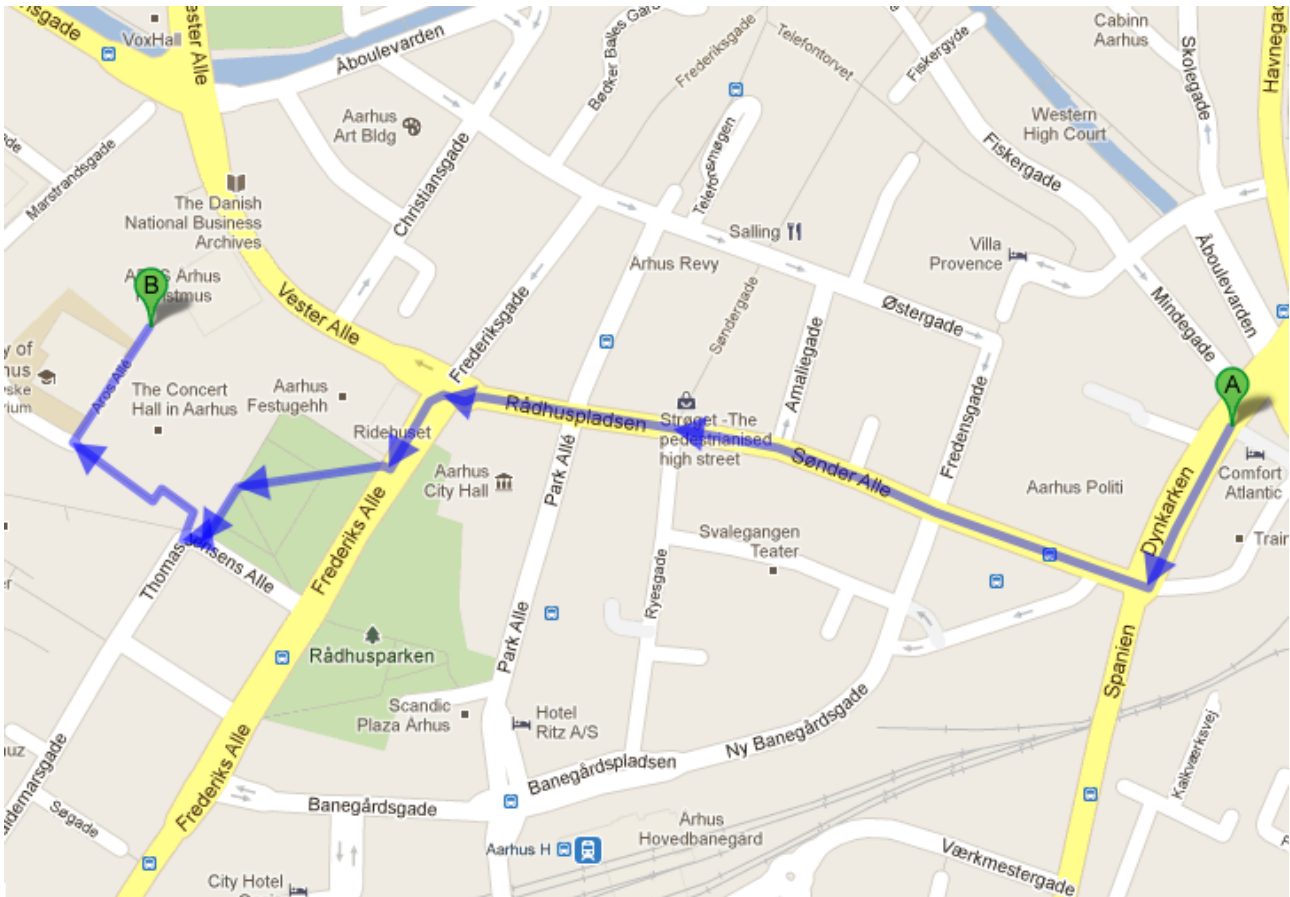
Saturday we will meet at the Department of Political Science, Building 1330/1331.
