From 2004 full professor of Classical Philology at Aarhus University, on leave 2011-2019 when I was director of the Danish Academy in Rome.

Most of Marianne Pade's publications in the last ten years have focused on Early Modern Latin language, literature and translation theory and practice, and in connection with this on Greek studies during the Renaissance. She is the author of c. 200 scholarly articles, monographs and edited volumes.
